Here is a fantastic material Helpful never heard of prior to his "trip". It is called Celastic and is best obtained from Sig Manufacturing Co. It feels and looks like a sheet of cardboard, but goes limp like wet silk when dipped in butyrate thinner. You can form this adhesive coated material around any kind of curve and it dries stiff and hard in a short time, ready to sand or paint. There are many uses for it, but the most common are for air ducting scoops, fillets around wings and tails, or reinforcements for wings, landing gear, or other needy places. It even works for a handy field repair.
