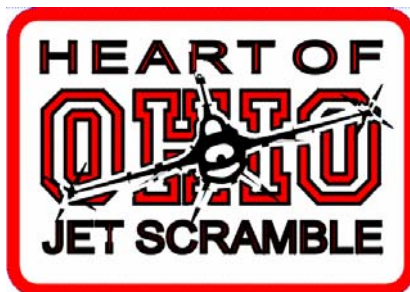

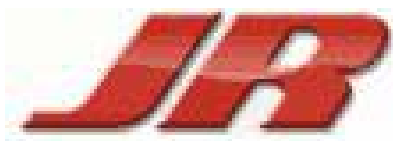
Help Support The Sponsors
