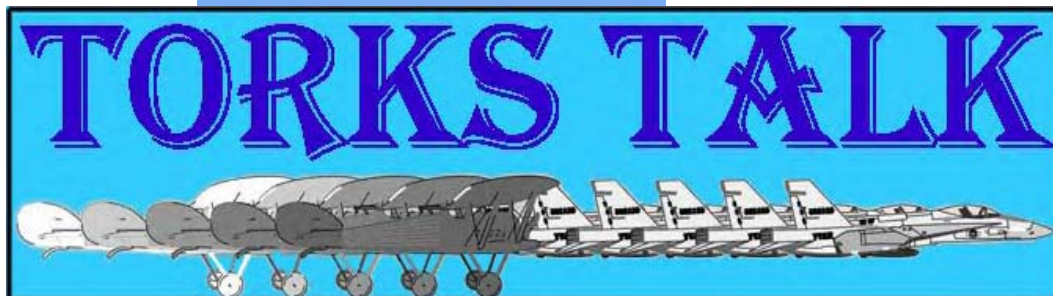

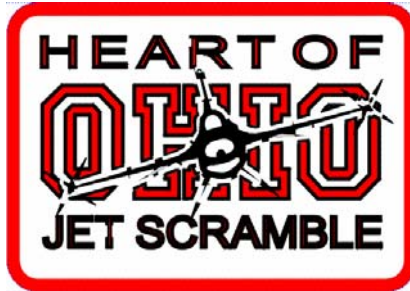

Jet Scramble 2005 – Terry Nitsch

Terry noted that things didn't work out last year at Darby Dan due to frequency problems and despite much speculation; no one could determine the cause for the problem. Therefore, no one would be back to fly at Darby Dan. The Jet Scramble committees and Exec Committee had met to determine the future of the event, and based on information at that time had decided to not continue the event. Since that time, Fayette County airport in Washington courthouse has now become a viable location for the event. Terry and Dave P recently made a trip to Washington CH and made a presentation to the Rotary club, and have garnered much support from the community. In addition, they have visited hotels, restaurants, etc. and reported that if the Torks wishes to support the event at Fayette County we could continue with the event for 2005. Terry noted that there is a local RC club at the airport with no reported interference problems. The airport is the perfect facility for a Jet event with a 5300' newly paved runway and is wide open. The airport is about 30 minutes from the Torks field. One of the local charities will handle all the parking for the event with the club getting 50% of the proceeds. Terry noted that we have an opportunity to not have to put as much effort into the event, have a little more fun, put on a first class event, and make money for the club. Greg asked for a gut reaction form the jet guys if the event would go. Terry said he already had commitment from Bob Violet, which means over 30 guys would return.

Terry noted that he must have a commitment from the club to support the event. Which means workers for the event. The event would be scheduled for August 26,27,28.

Terry motioned for a vote from the membership, but requested that a yes vote also meant that the voter was also volunteering to work at least one day of the event. The motion was seconded, and almost all members present voted the event in.
