**Trainers needed!!!!!! Please help out if you can!!!!!!**

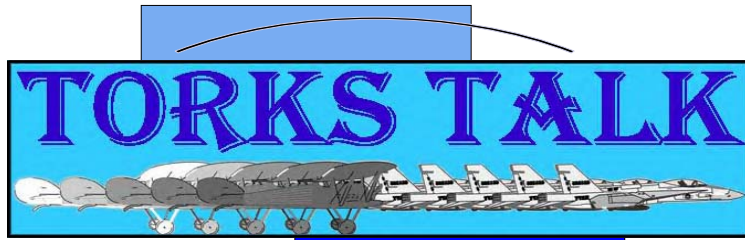
We have an abundance of trainees, and not a whole lot of trainers to fill the slots. Please contact Jermain Jones if you are interested.

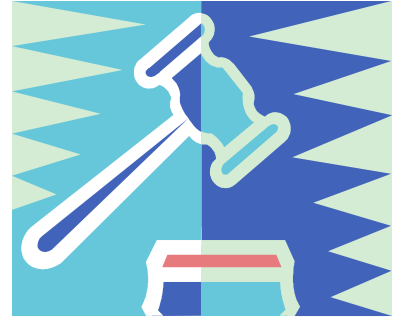
